

COVID-19: Investigating the origins


Two investigative journalists have led a forbidden investigation for five years. And this is what they discovered!

Between 13 and 17 million deaths from COVID, or one in every 500 people. That's the latest estimate from the WHO, making COVID the most devastating pandemic since the Spanish flu.

Yet, five years later, its origin remains a mystery. No one can explain precisely where the virus originated from or how it spread so rapidly and from the onset, superpowers that could help bring the truth to light – China and the U.S. – seem to have sought to conceal it. At best, they seek to distract from the subject matter. At worst, they lie. The topic has even become the focus of a diplomatic war between Beijing and Washington: fabricated evidence, false testimony, falsified or concealed scientific research... Anything goes. The case is as much about scientific manipulation as it is about politics. The virus first appeared in Wuhan, China, a stone's throw away from a high-security laboratory, but the Chinese Communist Party insists there is no correlation. The Americans, for their part, refuse to admit that they have financed high-risk research in that same laboratory.

Across the globe, men and women have vowed to solve the enigma: virus hunters in Vietnam, amateur detectives in New Zealand, a senator heading an investigative committee in Washington or a scientist at the WHO office in Geneva...






UNIT 414, the eyes of october 7


A VERY FRENCH SCAM The Man Who Sold Paris

LE MANS 55, the unauthorized investigation


A dive into the biggest tragedy of motor racing, through the eyes of the people who lived it.

On June 11th, 1955 at 6:28 p.m., the legendary 24Hrs of Le Mans race turned into a nightmare and became the deadliest in the history of motor sport. The Mercedes car n°20, driven by the Frenchman Pierre Levegh, collided with an Austin Healey before taking off in the crowded stands of the circuit. Official report: 82 dead and more than 120 injured. Despite this accident, the race continued, without the German team which deserted Le Mans overnight after withdrawing and ended the next day with the bitter victory of Jaquar.

Today, 65 years after the tragedy, numerous questions remain despite investigation, but one remains more important: why would the files be classified and sealed until 2031 when they should have been made public a long time ago?

When he arrived in London in 1996 to manage Premier League club Arsenal, 'Arsène Who?' was the headline that greeted the Frenchman. But over the course of the next 22 years 'Le Professeur' transformed not just Arsenal but the Premier League, imprinting his name on the history of English football. Wenger became Arsenal's most successful ever manager, but his vision, values and commitment to his work left a sporting and cultural legacy that would stretch far beyond the pitch.






